2. COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Rubber tape products based on synthetic elastomers and polyolefins.
Caution: for satisfactory and safe results, particularly with high voltage cables, correct procedures, as specified by the joint or cable manufacturer must be followed. rubbery materials, consisting mainly of polyisobutylene (pib), ethylene propylene rubber (epr), butyl rubber and other polyolefins, compounded with carbon black, mineral fillers and minor compounding ingredients.
Interleaving: pvc film or silicone coated release paper.

3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

There are no inherent hazards.
This tape will burn. combustion products include dark irritating smoke and possibly carbon monoxide, and oxides of nitrogen and sulphur.
Avoid inhalation: Where pvc interleaving is involved irritating, toxic fumes of hydrogen chloride will also be present.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Sweep up material and place in suitable containers for disposal.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Storage: Store in dry atmosphere at ambient temp: away from sources of ignition.

Apply normal industrial hygiene.

Soft rubbery tape, interleaved with a disposable pvc interleaving.

Colour: Black.
